Economic Impact

The LPGA Coates Golf Championship was held in Marion County January 26 to 31, 2015. One of 32 LPGA tournaments held throughout the world in 2015, the LPGA Coates Golf Championship brought 206 of the world's best golfers to Marion County.

"The immense economic impact and brand recognition to Marion County from the LPGA Coates Golf Championship was outstanding. The tournament brought tens of thousands of visitors to the community who spent over \$9.6 million throughout the county at local accommodations, restaurants, retail establishments, and attractions," exclaimed Loretta Shaffer, CDME, Executive Director of the Ocala/Marion County VCB, the organization tasked with bringing visitors to Marion County.

Shaffer added, "The entire economic impact of the tournament was over \$18.3 million as direct expenditures from tournament attendees worked their way through the local economy."

Room Nights and Attendees

- The LPGA Coates Golf Championship generated approximately 11,020* room nights
- 20% of attendees stayed in hotels, motels, etc.
- 9% of attendees stayed with friends and relatives
- 71% of attendees were day trippers or local residents
