Room Nights and Attendees

- The Ocala Jockey Club Int'l 3-Day Event had 4,200* attendees and generated 2,381* room nights
- 26% of attendees stayed in hotels, motels, etc.
- 9% of attendees stayed with friends and relatives
- 7% of attendees were day trippers
- 58% of attendees were local residents
